

ULTRA VIOLET (UV) MARKER PEN WITH AN ULTRA VIOLET LAMP IN THE PEN CAP

Police stations are now equipped with ultra-violet (UV) lamps to enable them to check and identify any stolen and retrieved property that has been 'invisibly' marked with an ultra-violet UV Marking Pen, such as the Walk Easy WE-510 UV Pen.

Property can be easily marked by anyone at home or in the office, onto numerous items including computers, photocopiers, documents; in fact the Police recommend marking any item that that is of intrinsic or sentimental value so that if it is lost or stolen and found by the Police the goods can be easily identified and returned to the rightful owner.

Use the Marker Pen to mark your possessions with your postcode and any other personal details, and check that this mark can only be seen under the ultra violet lamp contained in the cap of the pen.

Simply 'invisibly' mark your valuables with the Ultra Violet Marker Pen (suggest you mark with your house number and postcode e.g. 33/M11 6DR) and then check the 'invisible' marking with the Ultra Violet Light built into the pen cap.

Note: To initially ready the UV Lamp for activation, remove the plastic strip (in the pen cap) by pulling from under the battery. Then to activate the lamp simply depress the button on the side of the pen cap.

Record a list of the items that you have marked and the location of the mark on each item. The best location to mark is one where the mark is not exposed to direct sunlight.

In the event of one of these items being lost or stolen, then advise the police that the item has been security marked with an Ultra Violet Marker Pen.
